Gospel text (Lk 24,13-35): Two disciples of Jesus were going to Emmaus.

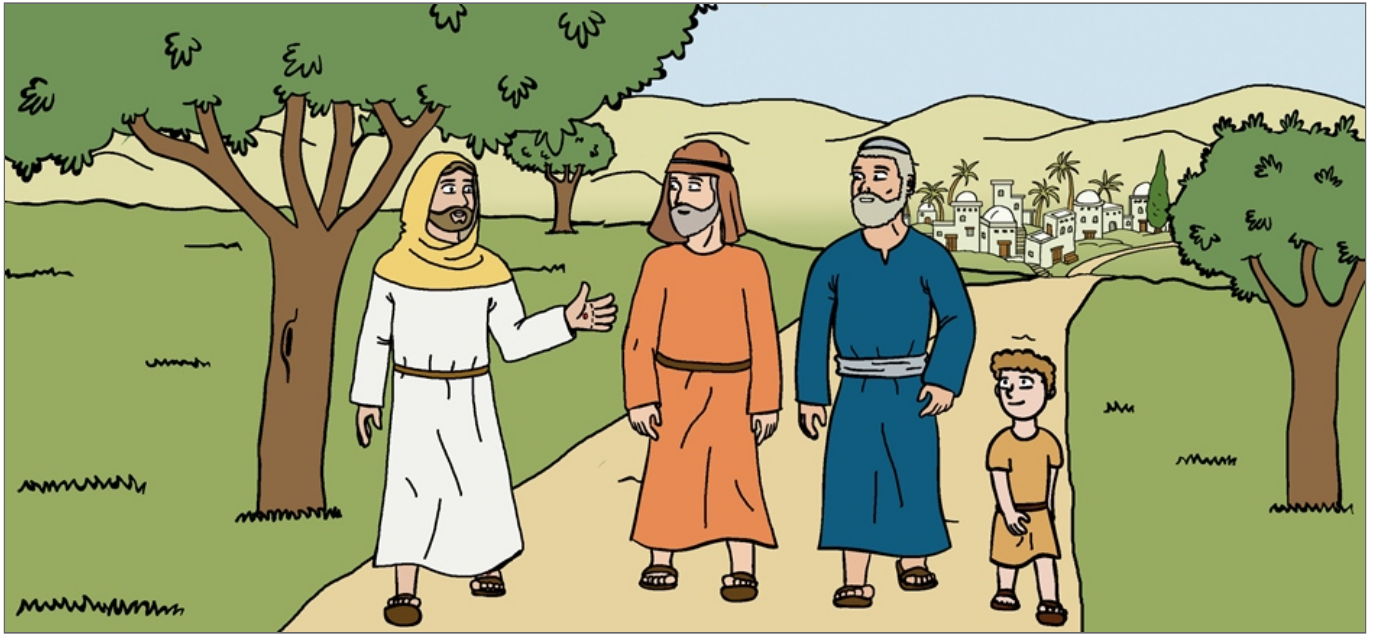
