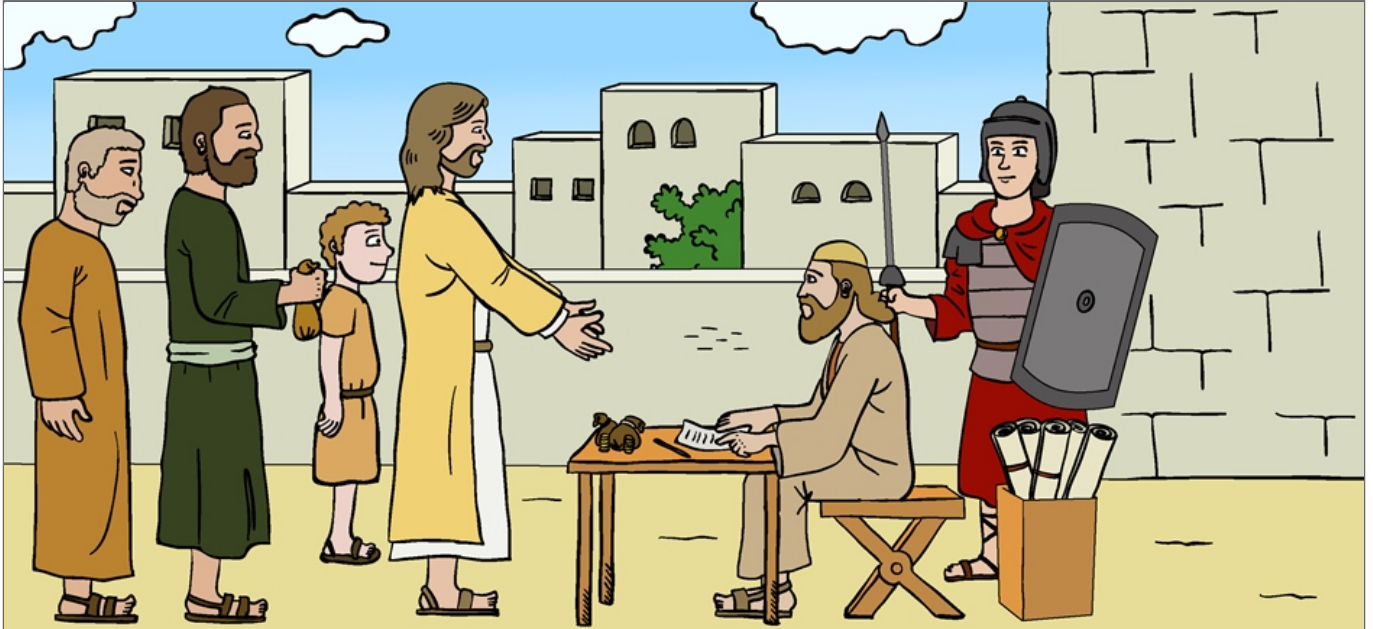


# Saturday 1st in Ordinary Time
