

# Monday of the Eighteenth Week in Ordinary Time

**Gospel text (Mt 14,13-21): He made everyone sit down on the grass. He took the five loaves and the two fishes, raised his eyes to heaven, pronounced the blessing, broke the loaves and handed them to the disciples to distribute to the people. And they all ate, and everyone had enough.**

Today we witness the first multiplication of bread and fish. It is an advance of the Eucharist. We do not usually count on God and then we totally overlook Him: there is not enough for everyone! (Some "wise" assumption).
