Gospel text (Lk 12,32-48): Jesus said to his disciples, «(...) Get yourselves purses that do not wear out, and make safe investments with God, where no thief comes and no moth destroys. For where your investments are, there will your heart be also».

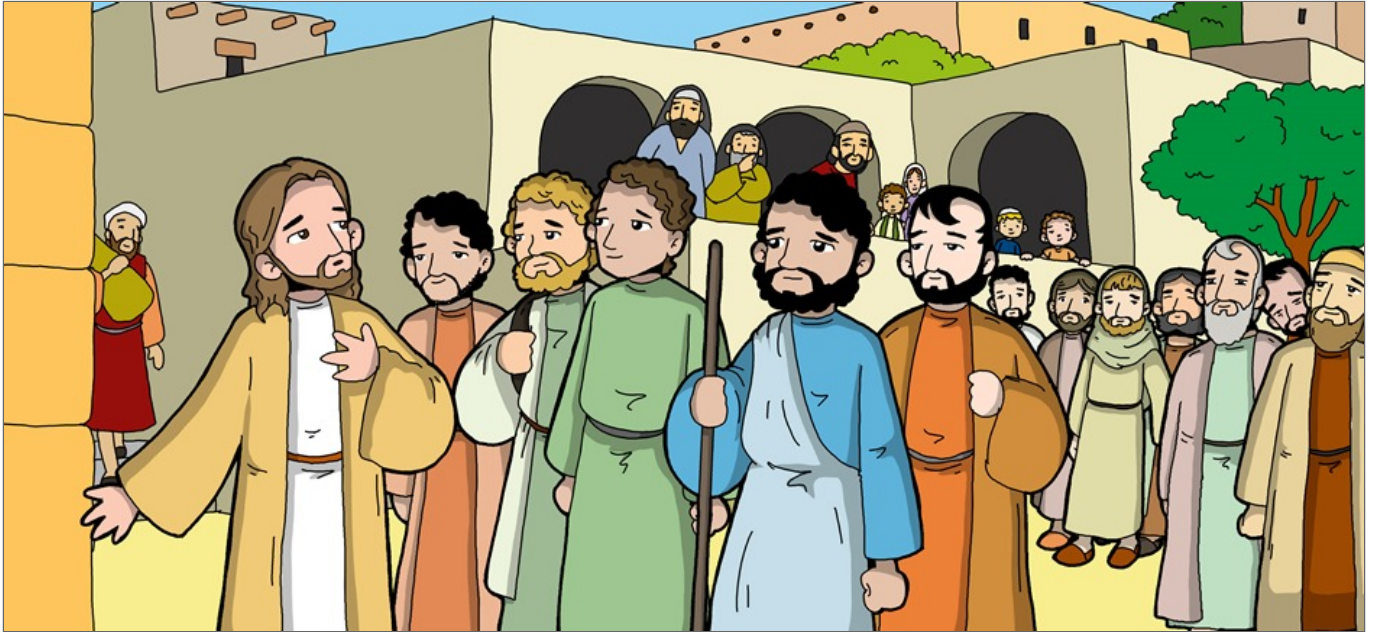

Today the Master invites us to clean up our hearts. What's in my heart? What is my treasure? Is it a treasure with "high expectations"? Or is it kidnapped by "fashions," "costumes," fleeting things ... If one lives "in disguise", then his heart ends up beaten and out of play.

- «Happy are those servants whom the master finds wide-awake when he comes». For this Jesus recommends to "gird up the loins" (no disguises!) and "lamps on" ("connected" through prayer).
