Gospel text (*Lk 16,1-13*): «The master commended the dishonest steward for his astuteness».

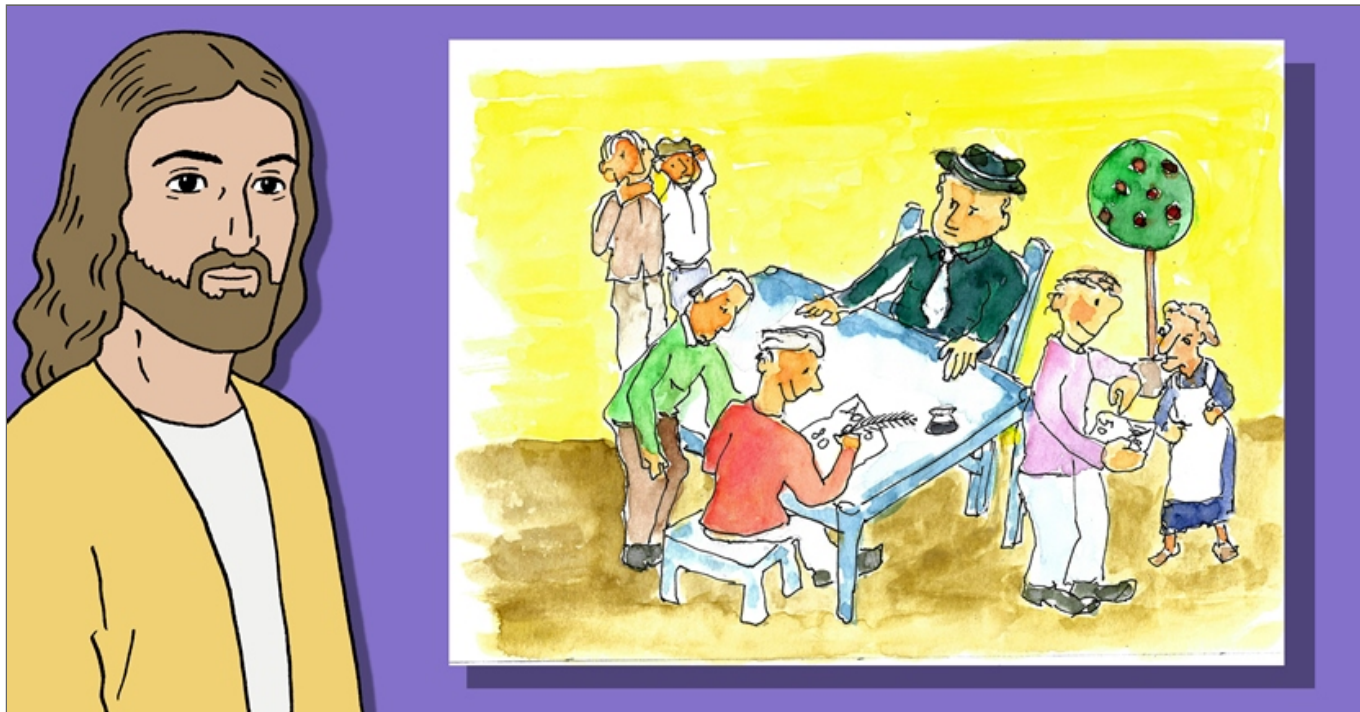
