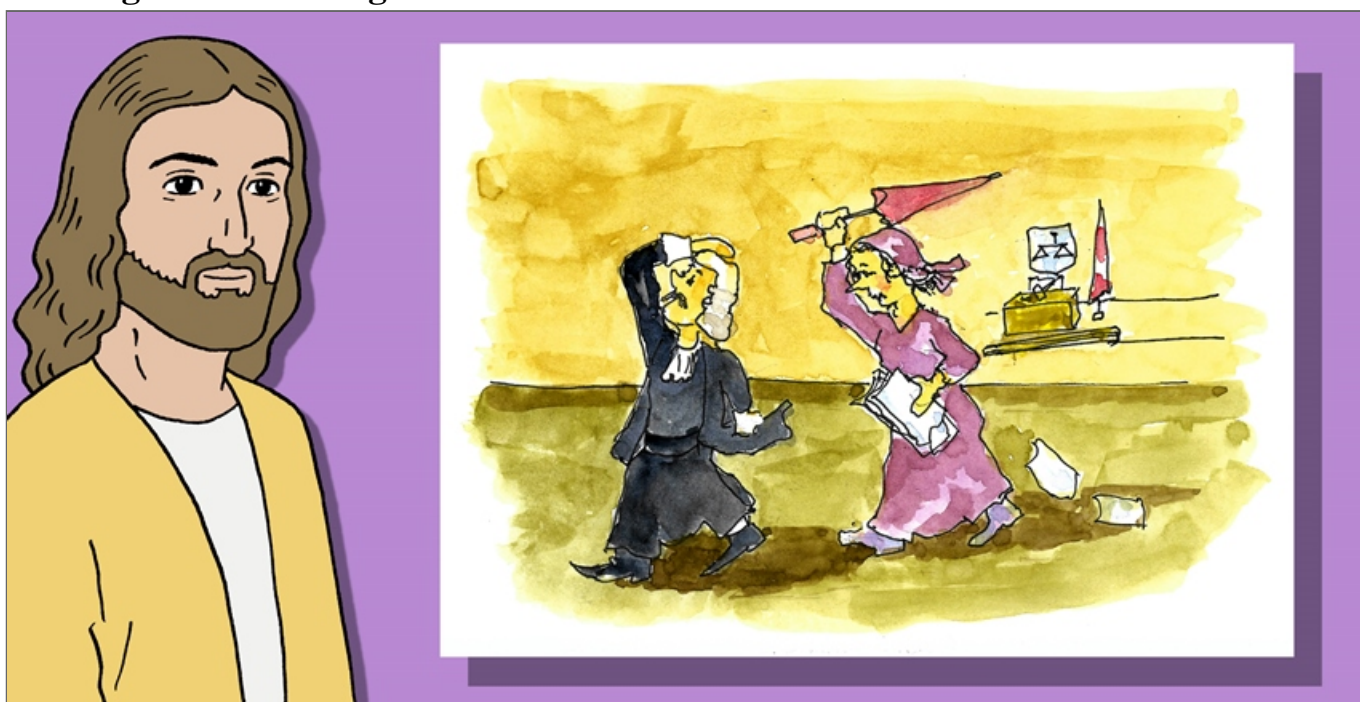


## Sunday 29th (C) in Ordinary Time

Gospel text (*Lk 18,1-8*): «In a certain town there was a judge who neither feared God nor people. In the same town was a widow who kept coming to him, saying: ‘Defend my rights against my opponent’. For a time he refused, but finally he thought: ‘Even though I neither fear God nor care about people, this widow bothers me so much I will see that she gets justice; then she will stop coming and wearing me out’».

Today we learn two lessons. First one: whoever does not fear God ends up disrespecting men. Second one: "When man does not know God, man does not know man" (Saint John Paul II).

- **Conclusion:** it is advisable to talk with God. Even more: "It is necessary to pray always without failing" (Jesus).
