Gospel text (Lk 17,7-10): «When you have done all that you have been told to do, you must say: ‘We are no more than servants; we have only done our duty’».

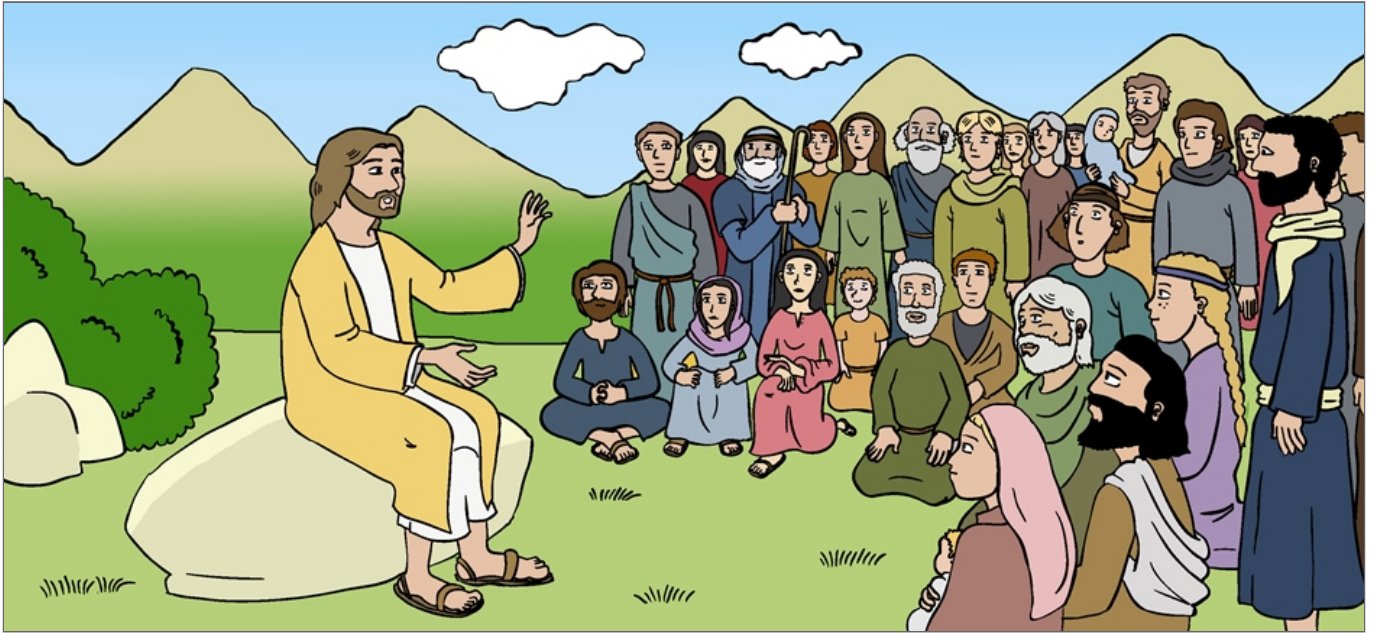
