Gospel text (Mk 1,21-28): In the city of Capernaum, on a Sabbath, Jesus went to the synagogue and began to teach. The people were astonished at the way He taught, for He spoke as one having authority and not like the teachers of the Law.

Today we see how the people with a humble heart perceive the strength of Christ's preaching, but they get angry with the scribes. Why? For the scribes, the first was to comply with the laws, regardless of the people; for Christ, the first was to help people (giving them health, food, consolation) and, at the same time, accompany them on the path of moral life.
