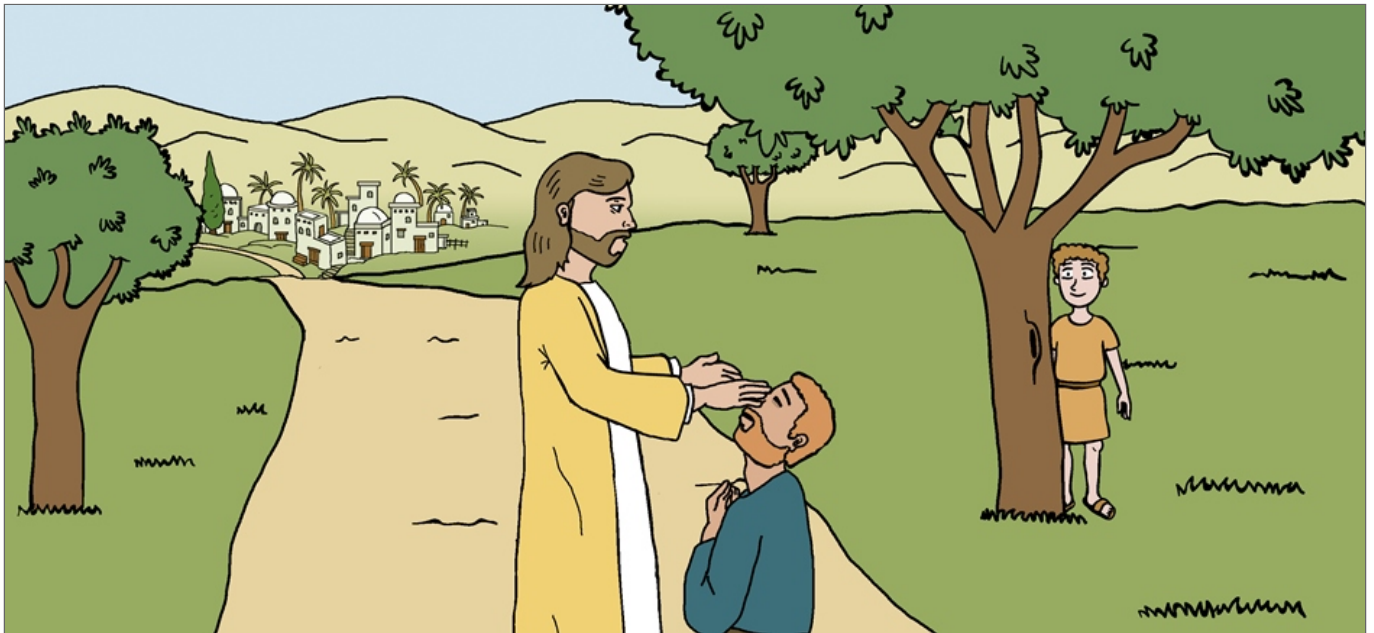


# Wednesday 6th in Ordinary Time
