Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (A)

Gospel text (*In* 6,51-58): Jesus said to the Jewish crowds: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us [his] flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "... Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him..."
